Philosophy Summer Camp for High School Students

Earn college credit at Portland State University!

In this summer camp students will develop critical thinking and academic writing skills in a discussion based, interactive format. Students will work on a major project with a Portland State University faculty member. Topics will include political philosophy, applied ethics (environmental ethics, animal ethics), philosophy of science, philosophy of art, indigenous philosophy, and the history of philosophy.

Students who successfully complete the camp will receive 4 credits for **Introduction to Philosophy** at Portland State University. Introduction to Philosophy transfers directly to most higher education institutions.

When

The summer camp will take place **Monday to Friday** from **9 a.m. – 1 p.m.** from **August 1 to 12, 2022.**

Who can attend?

High school students entering their junior or senior year in fall 2022.

Cost

The camp will be offered with a **reduced tuition rate of \$220**. Additionally, we offer full scholarships for all applicants who qualify for financial assistance.

Materials

All materials will be provided cost-free by the camp organizers. Camp participants will also have access to the Portland State University Library.

To participate

Submit the application form by Friday, July 1 along with a **300-500 word statement** on why you are interested in attending the philosophy summer camp.
